Achieved Advanced Standing by meeting requirements & submitting petition form. 2. Verify that you have completed ALL courses required of the program. 3. Passing scores on Basic Skills, Content Area, and APT tests. 4. Verify that there are no outstanding course or grade issues. 5. Verify a cumulative GPA of at least 2.50 for undergraduate students and major area GPA of 2.75. Graduate students must have at least 3.00 DePaul GPA. 6. World Language students must complete an Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) and indicate DePaul on form. <p>About Endorsements: if you have taken SCU 339 or SCG 439 we strongly recommend an endorsement evaluation with your advisor. Endorsements not reviewed prior to student teaching must be processed by ISBE after certification. Forms are available outside of SAC-481.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Questions? TB test - Results cannot be more than 90 days from when you will be entering the school. Submit results to SAC 481 or fax 773.325.4744. For test, go to: Target, CVS, Walgreens, Board of Health, or Sage Clinic about 2 months before you begin student teaching. 2. Required Number of Field Experience Hours (by program) logged on FEDS - The Office of Field Experiences and Student Teaching will audit FEDS and approve hours one month before student teaching. 3. Three Online Faculty Evaluations entered in FEDS. Professors will automatically post evaluations from 3 specific courses in your program. Verify on FEDS that evaluations have been entered. Contact professor if evaluation has not been entered. <p style="text-align: center;">COOPERATING TEACHER PACKET</p> <p style="text-align: center;">A packet will be available for pickup in SAC 481 about 1 month prior to student teaching. Contents include student teaching expectations and other essential materials.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">REGISTRATION FOR STUDENT TEACHING & CAPSTONE/SEMINAR</p> <p style="text-align: center;">The Office of Field Experiences and Student Teaching will register you approximately one month before student teaching for student teaching and for Capstone (Undergraduate) or Seminar (Graduate) courses.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Tuition is required for student teaching and for the Capstone (undergraduate)/Seminar (graduate) course.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Questions?
