

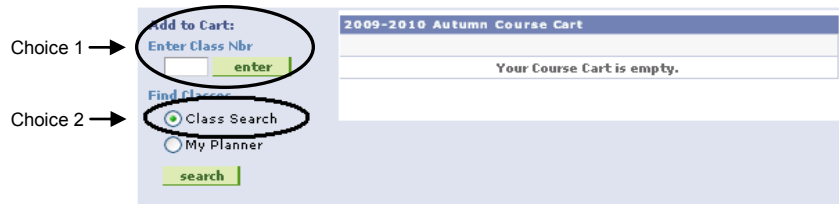


Get the Facts

Course Registration

Registering for class should be easy. After all, it's the most important thing you can do as a student (second to passing the class, of course). For the most part, registering is fairly simple, but in some respects, it can be a tad confusing, too. That's why we've decided to help! That way, you avoid any registration nightmares.

1. After you log in to Campus Connection, click the Student Center tab at the top, and then hit Enroll.
2. This will take you to the Course Cart*. From here you can either do one of two things. If you know the course's class number, enter the 5-digit code to add the class to your cart. If you don't know the course's class number, click the bubble next to "Class Search," and hit "Search."



3. The class search will lead you to the Course Catalog, where you can find the specific class via the respected school. Once you find your class, you can click "Select Class," then hit "Next," and it will be in your Course Cart.
4. In your Course Cart, select the class and click the green button, "Enroll." On the next screen, click on "Finish Enrolling." Now you may view your results by verifying and confirming your schedule.

But, what if the class is full?

If a class is full, but has a waitlist (there will be an orange triangle next to status), you can add yourself to the waitlist and as seats open up, students on the waitlist will be automatically enrolled. When you add yourself to the waitlist, you are given a position number.

Students are enrolled in open seats based on their position number. The lower the number, the higher your priority. These position numbers may be adjusted based on exceptions, which include whether you are student teaching next quarter or if this particular quarter is the last time a course is offered before your intended graduation.
