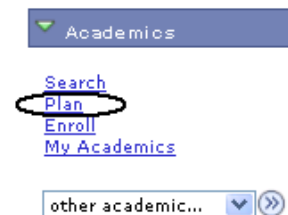
My Planner

Itching to plan your remaining academic career? No worries here. My Planner is your prime resource. Located on Campus Connection, the My Planner system lets you plan your future academic schedule for up to two years.

1. After you log in, go to the Student Center (tab at the top).



2. Your Student Center is your central mainframe, which houses your Academics, Finances, and Personal Information. Under Academics, look for the Plan link. Click on it.



3. You are now in My Planner. From here, you have two options. You can either browse the course catalog or plan by your requirements.



4. If you click on:

-Browse Course Catalog: A screen will open up with the entire course catalog within DePaul University. If you know the course title or prefix (e.g. ENG, T&L), you can search through the system alphabetically. When you find your course, check the box to the left of it and click the green button at the top or bottom that says, "Add to My Planner."

-Plan By My Requirements: The Degree Progress Report* will run, and you will be able to add the required courses that are within your declared track.

5. Don't want to take a particular course in the summer or fall? That's fine. At the bottom of My Planner, you will have the choice to move your courses to a different term of your liking.
