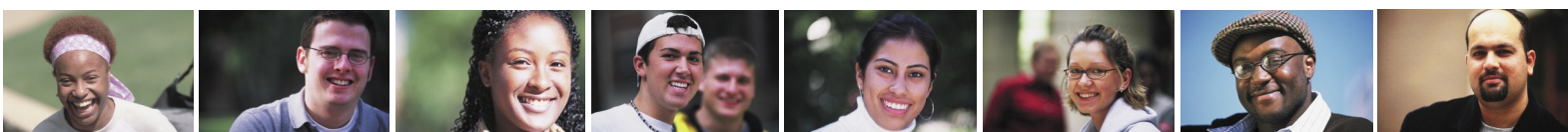
OrgSync (Student Organizations) — <https://orgsync.com/home>

Commuter Services (through Student Life)

Discount Information: \$6.00 AMC, \$5.50 Kerasotes (still accepted by AMC and Kerasotes theatres but being phased out), and \$6.50 Regal movie passes are always on sale in the Student Life offices. Passes are valid 10 days after the release date of the movie.

This law requires ALL students (degree and non-degree) born on or after January 1, 1957 and enrolled at half-time or more at a post-secondary institution to provide proof of immunization for Tetanus/Diphtheria, Measles, Mumps and Rubella.
