Academic Checklist ~ T&L Graduate Students

NOTE: This is based on a 2 year experience. If you are completing requirements at a different pace, consult your advisor.

* indicates there is a separate Get The Facts with information on this requirement.

First Quarter ~

- Take basic skills test *
- Take EDU 025
- Contact your content advisor for an evaluation (*secondary and language students only*)
- Begin pre-teacher education classes
- Maintain a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.00

Second Quarter ~

- Continue to take pre-teacher education classes
- Begin taking content area courses (if needed)
- Apply for advanced standing *
- Begin documenting clinical experiences in FEDS
- Begin considering possible student teaching locations
- Maintain a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.00

Third Quarter ~

- Begin advanced standing courses
- Continue to take content area courses (if needed)
- Attend student teaching meeting and apply for student teaching *
- Check on faculty recommendations for student teaching
- Maintain a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.00

Fourth Quarter ~

- Take content area test *
- Have conversation with advisor about endorsements
- Continue taking advanced standing and content area courses
- Maintain a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.00

Fifth Quarter ~

- Continue taking advanced standing and content area courses
- Submit official transcripts to advisor for courses taken outside of DePaul since admission.
- Complete clinical experiences
- Check with your advisor regarding academic clearance for student teaching *
- Take APT test (Assessment of Professional Teaching) *
- Maintain a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.00

Sixth Quarter ~

- Complete student teaching
- Apply for degree conferral and commencement ceremony *
- Apply for certification *
- Maintain a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.00

Seventh Quarter ~

- Take final course (if program requires courses after student teaching)
- Maintain a minimum cumulative gpa of 3.00
