Number of Graduates in Past Academic Year (2017-2018)

The Counseling Program conferred 76 degrees between July 1, 2017 and June 30, 2018. The breakdown by program is: CCSA – 14/18%; CMHC – 33/44%; SC – 29/38%.

Completion Rates

The program calculates its 4- and 6-year graduation rates following the cohort model used by IPEDS and established by the National Center for Education Statistics. Based on this model, the program's has a 80.76% 4-year graduation rate for the 2013 cohort and 79.59% 6-year graduation rate for the 2011 cohort.

Employment Rate

86% of the Counseling Program's graduating class of 2017 reported either employment or continuing education in the University Career Center's most recent survey of graduates.
