REGISTRATION FOR STUDENT TEACHING & CAPSTONE/SEMINAR

The Office of Field Experiences & Student Teaching will register you approximately one month prior to Student Teaching for Student Teaching and for Capstone (Undergraduates)/Seminar (Graduate) courses.

Tuition is required for Student Teaching and for the Capstone (Undergraduates)/Seminar (Graduate) courses. The \$300 edTPA fee will be charged to your account.

If you have financial aid it might get picked up depending on the FA package. If it is not picked up, it will be your responsibility to pay the edTPA testing fee.
