STAGE II Academic Clearance

Academic audit will verify you have completed the following:

- Achieved Advanced Standing by meeting requirements & submitting petition form.
- Verify that you have completed ALL courses required of the program.
- 3. Passing TAP, Content Area Test, OPI if World Language
- 4. No outstanding course or grade issues.
- 5. Undergraduates must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.50, and major GPA of at least 2.75.

Graduate students must have at least 3.0 DePaul GPA.

6. World Language students must complete the Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) and indicate DePaul on the form).

Endorsements:

If you have taken SCU 339 or SCG 439 an endorsement evaluation with your advisor is recommended.

STAGE III Student Teaching Approval

In order to be registered for Student Teaching and the Capstone/Seminar, the following must be completed by the deadline:

- TB test Results cannot be more than 90 days from when you will be entering the school (for everyone).
 Fax results to 773.325.4744. For test, go to Walk-In Clinic at: Target, CVS, Walgreens, Board of Health, or Sage Clinic about 2 months before you begin Student Teaching.
- Required Number of Field Experience Hours (by program) logged on FEDS - The Office of Field Experiences and Student Teaching will audit FEDS and approve hours one month before student teaching.
- Three Online Faculty Evaluations.
 Professors will automatically post evaluations in Digication from 3 specific (bold) courses in your program.

Information will be in Cooperating Teacher Corner on D2L please e-mail the forms to your Cooperating Teacher at least 1 month prior to Student Teaching.

Information for student teachers will be available on Student Teaching site on D2L.

REGISTRATION FOR STUDENT TEACHING & CAPSTONE/SEMINAR

The Office of Field Experiences and Student Teaching will register you approximately one month before Student Teaching for Student Teaching and for Capstone (Undergraduate) or Seminar (Graduate) courses.

Tuition is required for Student Teaching and for the Capstone (undergraduate)/Seminar (graduate) course.

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
